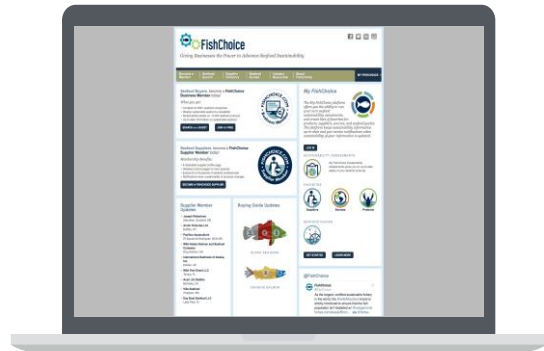

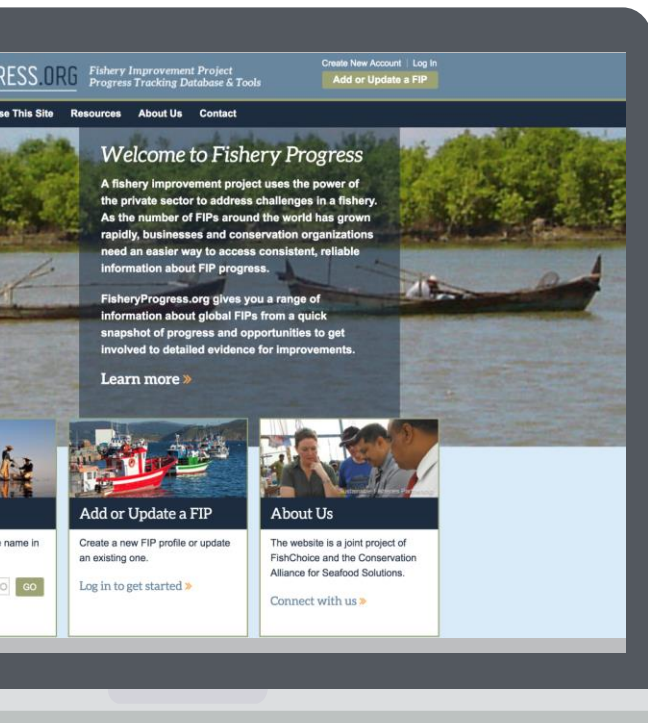


## THE CHALLENGE

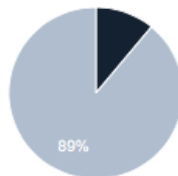

## Overview

### FIP Description

The Panama Republic is a relatively small country in surface (75,000 Km<sup>2</sup>), but has a substantial biological potential as seafood producing country thanks to its geographic location.

### FIP Objective(s)

The goal of the Panama Large Pelagics Longline & Green stick FIP is to strengthen the harvest strategy, related harvest control rules and the management system to reach, for the fall of 2024, a minimum score of 60-79 for all the principle 2 and 3 performance indicators for the MSC Standard.

Project outcomes for 2024 are:

- To establish a fishery monitoring and data collection program to document and evaluate the fishery impacts to biodiversity.
- To develop a management strategy to mitigate the fishery impacts on secondary and PET species
- To promote, at the RFMO level, the development and publication of a robust and comprehensive stock assessment for dolphin fish.
- To Promote, at the RFMO level, the development and implementation of a harvest strategy and control rules for dolphin fish in the area of jurisdiction of the the IATTC.
- To promote updates to the national fishery regulatory to meet the sustainability standards internationally accepted.
